

Help For Ukrainian Refugees

Anabaptist Ukrainian Refugee Assistance (AURA) has been organized by brethren from various American Anabaptist churches with the goal of helping address needs arising from the current Ukrainian crisis. We desire to help first the household of faith and do good to all men as we have opportunity.

Objectives in focus;

1. Assist in channeling resources to the immediate needs of refugees.
2. As the right path forward becomes clearer, assist refugees returning home, or with immigration and resettlement.
3. Develop a channel of communication with American officials to encourage opening doors and offer assistance from the Anabaptist community for refugees who contact us requesting help to immigrate to the US.

The immediate need is funding for lodging, food, transportation, and other costs for refuge needs. The number of refugees keeps increasing daily. We are listing three avenues of providing immediate aid.

1. Master's International Ministries sponsors an Anabaptist church in the village of Shipintsi, Ukraine, close to the Romanian border. This church is assisting refugees on the Ukrainian side. Funds to assist this work should be marked 'Ukraine Refugee Fund' and sent to:
